


Difference between

To & For

- The word “To” can be used as infinitive maker or as a preposition.
- To is used for comparing, giving, direction, distance, destination and motivations.



- The “for” is a preposition that is followed by a gerund or a noun.
- For is used for agreeing, explaining function, schedule benefits and period of time etc.

Examples

Sheeza came here to see me.	She have made an appointment for 2 nd June.
They will go to London.	This school is very famous for producing scientists.
It's about 25 kilometers from my shop to home.	Let's go out for a morning walk.
He is very rude and want to go abroad.	We lived here for 3 years.
Neha gave a camera to her younger brother.	Healthy diet is good for body.
I used to take bath in the early morning.	We will leave for Lahore.
She don't want to visit me in hospital.	She is looking for a new job.
She prefers reading to eating.	Ali was waiting for her girlfriend.
